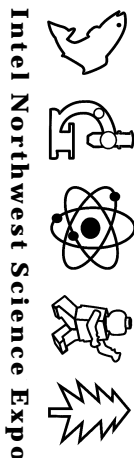

The Northwest Science Expo System (NWSES)

NWSES includes seven regional fairs and a state fair for students in grades 5-12. All system fairs are affiliated with the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair. Participants are welcome from anywhere in Oregon and Clark County, Washington.

Three Ways to Help

Be a Judge

- Judges are the most vital contact with our students.
- Judging day includes time for review of posters, interviews with students, and decision making.
- We recommend judges participate in at least one regional fair in addition to Intel NWSE.
- Judge registration is available online at affiliatedfairs.org.

Be a Sponsor

- Category award sponsors provide \$50 for first place winners.
- Sponsors select division and category they wish to support.
- Sponsors are listed on the NWSE website and announced at award ceremonies.

High School: Animal Sciences, Behavioral & Social Sciences, Biochemistry, Cellular & Molecular Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Earth Science, Engineering, Energy & Transportation, Environmental Analysis, Environmental Management, Mathematics, Medicine & Health, Microbiology, Physics & Astronomy, Plant Sciences.

Middle School: Animal Science & Microbiology, Behavioral & Social Sciences, Chemistry & Earth, Computer Science & Mathematics, Consumer Product Testing, Engineering, Energy & Transportation, Environmental Science, Medicine & Health, Physics, Plant Science.
